RE: CHIEF'S REPORT

OLD BUSINESS

- **RADIO PURCHASE:** I am finalizing the order with Ancom Communications, Inc. for the purchase of the department mobile and portable radios. I expect the equipment will be installed in time for Pepper Festival.

NEW BUSINESS

- **ACTIVE SHOOTER EXERCISE:** On Tuesday, June 9, 2015, I participated in an exercise at the Hudson High School related to an active shooter. Law Enforcement, Fire, EMS, School District Staff and other entities put on a live exercise with a lot of moving parts to simulate an active shooter scenario at the Hudson High School. I found the training extremely beneficial and enjoyed watching all the disciplines work together to bring calm to a chaotic scene. The exercise was very realistic.
- **CLICK IT OR TICKET MOBILIZATION:** Committee members may have seen an increase in traffic stops over the past few weeks as NHPD had been participating in the national mobilization to enforce seat belt violations and remind people to buckle up.
- **SEAT BELT STUDY:** The NHPD Intern has been tasked with data collection of different traffic related issues for the department including a seat belt study (non-scientific). I have attached the results of her study, which showed 18.6% of motorists in North Hudson were not wearing their seat belts as required by law, which is higher than the national average of 17.6%. I have attached the analysis sheets from the Intern's study to this report for your review.

Seatbelt Data:

The data was logged on the 26th of May and the 1st of June in 2015. At the intersections of Wisconsin St. N. and 6th St. N. and St. Croix St. N. and 6th St. N. in the Village of North Hudson. As vehicles drove past the observer the type of vehicle was noted (Car; SUV/Van; Truck or larger) and whether or not the driver and passenger (if applicable) in the vehicle were wearing a seatbelt or not.
