Topic

To temporarily amend the Class "B" / "Class B" Retail License for the sale of Fermented Malt Beverages and Intoxicating Liquors for the Mallalieu Inn's spring motorcycle run. The event will take place on Saturday, April 9, 2016 from 10:00 am until 2:00 pm.


Background

Sandy Moelter, owner of the Mallalieu Inn, 414 Wisconsin Street North, requests an extension of premises each year in the spring and fall for a motorcycle run. A written request for the spring 2016 motorcycle run event has been received. A route map was not provided. The request has been reviewed by Police Chief Mark Richert and he has recommended approval with conditions as stated in the suggested motion.

Suggested Motion

Move that the Class "B" / "Class B" Retail License for the sale of Fermented Malt Beverages and Intoxicating Liquors for Mallalieu Inn be temporarily amended for an event taking place April 9, 2016 with the following conditions:

- 1) Possession of open containers of alcohol outside of the establishment shall remain within Mallalieu Inn parking lot and blocked off street area for event (Wisconsin St N from 3rd St N to 6th St N).
- 2) Use of outside area only with specific permission of Village Board for each particular date and event. The April 9, 2016 event to be from 10:00 am to 2:00 pm.
- 3) Three (3) North Hudson police officers and three (3) St. Croix County Deputies to be on duty during the hours of the event at the owner's expense, to be billed to the owner by the Village.
- 4) Owner to provide adequate, satellite restroom facilities.
- 5) Wisconsin Street North, from 6th St. N. to 3rd St. N., to be closed to thru traffic from 10:00 am to 2:00 pm with an open corridor for emergency vehicles maintained (surrounding neighbors to be notified in advance by the Village). Actual times of detour route are at the discretion of the commanding NHPD officer on scene.
- 6) Payment for Village services must be paid within thirty (30) days after the event.

The annually scheduled Spring motorcycle run is scheduled for April 9, 2016. It is my understanding that Ms. Moelter once again requested an extended premises amendment to her Class "B"/Class B Retail License for the sale of Fermented Malt Beverages and Intoxicating Liquors.

It should be noted that in past years, the request has been from 10:00 AM to 2:00 PM and those times are adequate to facilitate the safety of those participants along Wisconsin St. N.

I recommend approval of the upcoming request with the following conditions, similar to the Fall 2015 request:

- 1) Possession of Open containers of alcohol outside of the establishment shall remain within Mallalieu Inn parking lot and blocked off street area for event (Wisconsin St. N. from 3rd St. N. to 6th St. N.).
- 2) Use of outside area only with specific permission of Village Board for each particular date and event. The Saturday, April 9, 2016, event to be from 10:00 AM to 2:00 PM.
- 3) Three (3) North Hudson police officers and three (3) St. Croix County Deputies to be on duty during hours of event at owner's expense, to be billed to the owner by the Village.
- 4) Owner to provide adequate, satellite restroom facilities.
- 5) Wisconsin Street North, from 6th Street North to 3rd Street North, to be closed to thru traffic from 10:00 AM to 2:00 PM with an open corridor for emergency vehicles maintained (surrounding neighbors to be notified in advance by the Village). Actual times of detour route are at the discretion of the commanding NHPD officer on scene.
- 6) Payment for Village services must be made within thirty (30) days after event.

I will make the usual and customary notification as in previous years (e.g. Hudson PD, Hudson Fire, Hudson EMS, St. Croix County Sheriff's Department, Wisconsin State Patrol, etc.).
