ORDINANCE NO. ___-201_

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE MUNICIPAL CODE FOR THE VILLAGE OF NORTH HUDSON, WISCONSIN

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Village of North Hudson wishes to amend Chapter 90 Traffic and Vehicles, Article IV. Traffic Schedules, Division 2 Parking, of the Village of North Hudson Municipal Code. (Deleted language is struck through, created language is underlined.)

NOW THEREFORE, the Board of Trustees of the Village of North Hudson does ordain as follows:

Sec. 90-142. Definitions.

The following words, terms and phrases, when used in this article, shall have the meanings ascribed to them in this section, except where the context clearly indicates a different meaning:

Implement shall mean any device, not a trailer, capable of being towed by a vehicle.

Owner shall mean a person, other than a secured party, having the property in or clear title to a motor vehicle, including a lessee.

Person shall mean a natural person, firm, association, corporation, or governmental organization.

Street shall mean any street, alley, avenue, drive, place, or any other public way in the Village.

Vehicle shall mean every device in, upon, or by which any person or property is or may be transported or drawn upon a highway, except devices moved by human power.

Sec. 90-143. Parking Prohibition.

(a) Between the first day of November and the first day of April following, there shall be no vehicle, trailer, or implement left unattended or parked on any street or alley within the corporate limits of the Village of North Hudson between the hours of 3:00 a.m. and 7:00 a.m.

(b) Following the accumulation of two (2) inches or more of snowfall in the Village, it shall be unlawful for the driver or owner to park such vehicle, trailer, or implement on any street or alley within the Village of North Hudson. Parking may not be resumed on any street or alleys until snow removal has been completed curb to curb. Any police officer who finds a motor vehicle in violation of this paragraph or during an active snow removal operation shall attempt to contact the owner of the motor vehicle and require the owner to immediately remove the motor vehicle so as not to be in violation of this section. If the owner does not immediately remove the

motor vehicle or the owner cannot be located, the police officer is authorized to have the motor vehicle removed pursuant to Sec. 90-144 of this Article.

Sec. 90-144. Violations, Fines and Penalties-Removal of Illegally Parked Vehicles.

Any vehicle parked in violation of this chapter is hereby declared to be a nuisance and may be summarily abated by removing such vehicle. The Police Department is hereby authorized to remove and tow away or have removed and towed away by commercial towing services, any vehicle parked in violation of this chapter or the Statutes of Wisconsin, or any vehicle which blocks the use of a fire hydrant, or obstructs or may obstruct the movement of any emergency vehicle. Vehicles so impounded shall be surrendered to the owner or operator thereof upon proper identification to the vehicle storage facility and only upon payment of the towing and storage fees assessed against said vehicle. Vehicles so impounded may be placed at any commercial establishment operating vehicle storage facilities or at a public vehicle pound established by the Village.
