**Chief's report**

**Multiple Car Break-ins:** In October 2015, NHPD received six reports of unlocked vehicles, which had been entered and the garage door openers and other minor valued items removed. In mid-November, Hammond PD was notified of a resident who caught two males rummaging through his vehicles. Richert had the opportunity to interview one of the suspects. The 21-year old suspect confessed to the car break-ins in North Hudson and advised the other male arrested in Hammond was also present and participated in the vehicle break-ins.

**Damage to Property:** On Monday, December 7, 2015, NHPD took a report of a car with both back door windows shattered in the 500 block of 5<sup>th</sup> Street N. On Tuesday, December 8, 2015, NHPD took a report of a rear window of an SUV in the 100 block of 6<sup>th</sup> Street N. was shattered from a single hole in the film. Richert stated he posted information on the NHPD Facebook page reminding the public to report any suspicious activity or to report any information they may have regarding these incidents.
