

**Village of North Hudson

**Call to Order: roll call**

Chairman Zappa called the meeting to order at 5:31 p.m. Answering the call were Trustee Nelson and Trustee Pike. A quorum was present and the meeting was duly noticed. Also in attendance was Chief Richert and recording secretary, Traci Miller.

**Questions/comments from the floor**

No one was in attendance.

**Minutes approval from May 7, 2015 meeting**

**Motion (Nelson/Pike) to approve the May 7, 2015 meeting minutes as written. Motion carried.**

**Chief's report**

Richert stated that he is finalizing the order with Ancom Communications, Inc. for the purchase of the department mobile and portable radios. He expects the equipment to be installed in time for Pepper Festival.

On Tuesday, June 9, 2015, Richert participated in an exercise at Hudson High School related to an active shooter situation. Law Enforcement, Fire, EMS, Hudson School District staff and other entities coordinated a real life exercise. Richert stated he found the exercise to be extremely helpful and felt everyone involved benefitted. Pike asked whether a report will be available in the future regarding this exercise. Richert stated he was not in charge of this, but believed there will be.

Richert stated there has been an increase in traffic stops over the past few weeks as NHPD has been participating in the national mobilization to enforce seat belt violations and remind people to buck up. He also stated that the NHPD intern had been tasked with data collection of different traffic related issues for the department including a seat belt study, which he included for the committee's review.

The police commission is having their annual meeting on Monday, June 22 from 6:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. at the Village Hall. He stated he will be making a presentation regarding the "Science of Force" at this event and invited everyone to attend.

The committee reviewed recent cases and traffic and municipal citation tallies for May. There was a slight increase for May due to traffic mobilization activity.

**FY2016 Budget**

Richert stated he is in the process of establishing projected numbers for the 2016 Budget. He will bring this to the committee for review at the July Public Safety meeting. Discussion followed.

**Police Department Capital Equipment Planning**

Richert indicated he has a packet of information regarding the maintenance costs of a NHPD car and will break that information down for the committee's review to present at a future meeting. Discussion followed.
