Minutes

Call to order; Invocation; roll call

President Stan Wekkin called the meeting to order at 4:00 p.m. Answering the call were Trustees Leaf, Nelson, Pike, and Zappa. A quorum was present and the meeting had been duly noticed. It was noted that Trustees Head and Zais were absent. Also in attendance were the Police Chief, Mark Richert; Public Works Director, Patrick Moos; and Village Administrator/Clerk, Melissa Luedke.

Storm Damage Clean-Up, Pick-Up of Tree Debris and Street Sweeping

Wekkin stated that as a result of the storm on Sunday, June 11, 2017, there are a number of downed trees. There have been a lot of questions from residents as to if the Village will be picking up the tree debris. This service was provided after the last big storm in 2013. Street sweeping will also need to be done so leaves do not plug up the catch basins. Moos stated that Public Works will need outside help to pick up the tree debris due to the amount and size of some of the limbs. Moos stated that he prefers to pick up curb side and not allow residents to drive into the Shop Yards to drop off. Some of the wood will be saved and chipped to be used in the parks. The Village is working with the County to see if we qualify for some disaster relief funds from the state. Zappa suggested having a place in the Village for residents to drop off tree debris versus picking up curbside. There is some concern regarding residents driving into the Shop Yards and if there is any liability. It was decided to provide curb pick-up of tree debris. Richert stated that as part of the emergency proclamation signed by Wekkin, there is a \$14,000 threshold that the Village needs to meet to be eligible for disaster relief funds from the State. Picking up debris on private property cannot be added to this threshold amount if it doesn't meet one of the criteria by the state. Pick-up and deadline information will be put on the Village website. **Motion (Pike/Leaf) to approve having Public Works and SavATree pick-up tree debris as a result from the storm on June 11, 2017. Also, to have the streets swept after tree debris pick-up is completed. Motion passed on a roll call vote of 5-0. Nelson-yes, Pike-yes, Wekkin-yes, Zappa-yes, Leaf-yes.**

Adjournment

Wekkin declared the meeting adjourned at 4:23 p.m.
