




# Background

- ▶ Project partially funded through WisDOT Surface Transportation Program - Urban
- ▶ Objective of Program is to fund eligible highways in urban areas
- ▶ Program covers up to 80% of roadway improvements
- ▶ Funding applied for in the 2015-2020 cycle
- ▶ Project is entirely separate from WIS 35 project scheduled for construction in 2021




# Project Limits

Limits extend from 6<sup>th</sup> Street North to 3<sup>rd</sup> Street North (WIS 35)



# Existing Conditions

## Existing Typical Section



- ▶ Project Length: Approximately 800-ft
- ▶ Existing Typical Section
  - ▶ 36-feet from face of curb to face of curb
  - ▶ Roadway bounded by 24-inch curb and gutter
  - ▶ Sidewalk along north side throughout limits
- ▶ ADT: 1500 Vehicles per day
- ▶ Speed Limit: 25 MPH

# Project Need

## ▶ Poor Pavement Condition

- ▶ Longitudinal Cracking
- ▶ Transverse Cracking

## ▶ Utility Condition

- ▶ Sanitary, Water and Storm
- ▶ All poor condition due to age


## ▶ Pedestrian Safety

- ▶ Curb ramps are not compliant with American with Disability Act (ADA) requirements
  - ▶ Lack of Warning Fields
  - ▶ Steep grades
- ▶ Lack of curb ramps at Willow River Apartments



# Roadway Improvements

## Proposed Typical Section



- ▶ Proposed street width matches existing
- ▶ All curb and gutter replaced
- ▶ Roadway to consist of 4-inches of Asphalt over 10-inches of base aggregate
- ▶ All driveway and access points to remain
- ▶ Sidewalk and curb ramps replaced/reconfigured to meet ADA compliance





# Right of Way (ROW) Acquisition

- ▶ Existing right of way is approximate back of sidewalk
- ▶ Sidewalk replacement and utility work will extend beyond existing street ROW
- ▶ Temporary Limited Easements will be required for construction
  - ▶ “A Temporary Limited Easement (TLE) (RE1577) is an interest in land and must be used when the project requires WisDOT or its contractors to use a portion of the owner’s property temporarily to construct the highway project.”
  - ▶ After construction is complete, this property reverts back to property owner.
- ▶ A right of way plat will be prepared and agents will meet with property owners to discuss compensation.

# Construction Cost

- ▶ Roadway Related Work
  - ▶ \$450,000
  - ▶ Federal Funds: 80%
  - ▶ Municipal Funds: 20%
- ▶ Utility Related Work (Sanitary and Water)
  - ▶ \$200,000
  - ▶ Federal Funds: 0%
  - ▶ Municipal Funds: 100%

Preliminary Design	Ongoing
Final Design	2021
Real Estate Acquisition	2021
Construction	Summer 2022*

- ▶ Project must be substantially completed by September 1, 2022
